WHAT IS A REQUEST FOR INFORMATION?



Request for Information (RFI): Formal process to gather public comments on policy and program questions

- ✓ Allows for dialogue
- ✓ Information gathered will be shared publicly
- ✓ Many opportunities to provide feedback
- ✓ Extended comment period
- ✓ Tribal Consultation Nov. 29-30, 2023 (in person)

POSSIBLE IMPACTS

How might the RFI inform CCDF policies or requirements for Tribal Nations?



Regulations through a future NPRM



Subregulatory guidance such as Program Instructions and Information Memoranda



Changes to Information Collections, such as plan questions and reporting questions



Technical assistance such as national webinars and tailored or individualized support



Step #1: Choose the topic you want to post feedback, click the three dots and then "Add Post"




Step #2: Write and publish your comment





BREAKOUT ROOM ACCESS


1. To select a breakout room, click on the **Breakout Room** icon at the bottom of the screen.




- 2. The breakout room options appears. Select a room of your choice and click the blue **Join** button.
- 3. To confirm, click the blue **Yes** button.




4. The top right title displays the name of the room you're in.


